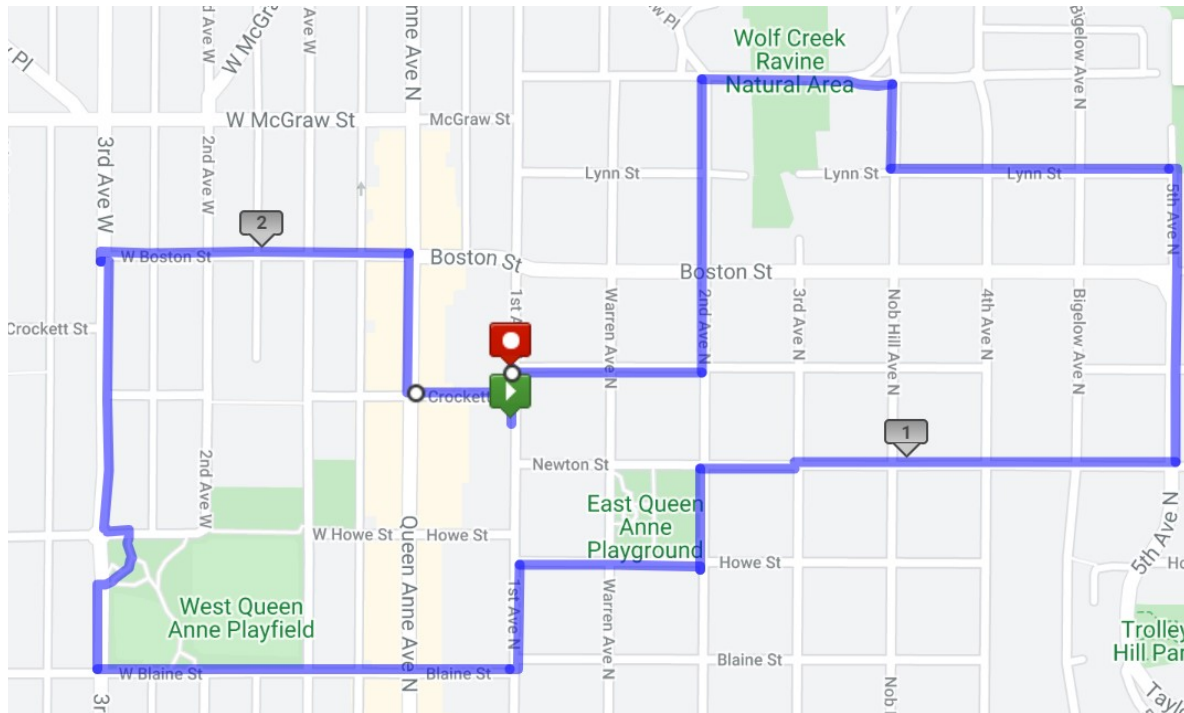


Neighborhood Prayer Guide
